Dear Mr Guinn:

Thank you for your efforts to understand and manage the Red Lake. This letter is to notify you that the DNR will approve the Red Lake 2019-2023 Aquatic Plant Management Plan (Plan) provided the contingencies described below are met. Approved management recommendations specified below are eligible for funding under Lake Management Planning, Lake Protection and Classification, and Aquatic Invasive Species grants subject to the application requirements of those programs.

Approved management recommendations include the following:

1. AIS prevention activities, including watercraft inspection and volunteer monitoring.
2. Aquatic plant and water quality monitoring.
3. Educational activities, including AIS workshops, signage, etc.
4. AIS control, depending on contingencies below.

This approval is contingent on the following:

1. The Plan should be posted to your website for public comment. The opportunity for public review is required for final plan approval and eligibility for grant funding.
2. The Department may require a liquid 2,4-d product be used instead of a granular product, especially if surface water grant funding is used.
